The meeting was fairly well attended and everyone present felt that it was quite informative.

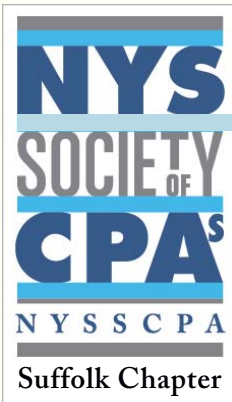

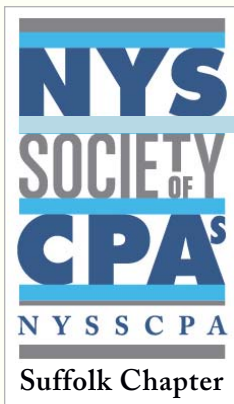

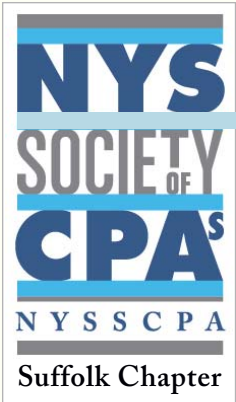
